June 21, 2016

1) Minutes from the May 17, 2016 meeting were amended as follows:

2) Issues, Comments and Questions

There has been movement by Panda Express to begin re-construction work on Illinois Ave.

Regarding traffic signal timing along the Turnpike, Roger says that without pedestrian buttons being pressed or other asynchronous interruptions in the timing, one can go from one end of town to the other and hit all green lights if one is traveling the posted speed limit. However, as soon as a ped button interrupts the timing it can take up to a half hour for the other signals to re-synch.

The close-date for the mall purchase is June 28. Progress is being made and hopefully documents will be signed by the 28th.

One of our road paving contracts is in dispute so a few of the streets that were pegged for resurfacing will have to wait a bit longer.

The process has begun to work on intersections at Tulane and Tenneson.

The building to the right of where the Atomic Bar used to exist is being renovated and may end up containing a Sears appliance store. However, the lots the building sits upon will need to go through a bit of rezoning.

The grant to complete sidewalks on the south side of the Turnpike between New York and Laboratory Roads is in the process and appears hopeful.

A grant application has been submitted for the replacement of older signal equipment. Once older equipment is upgraded, the replacement components can then hook into our central timing system.

Highland Ave between Robertsville and Henley is getting rutted.

3) A motion to adjourn was made and passed unanimously.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:55 pm.
